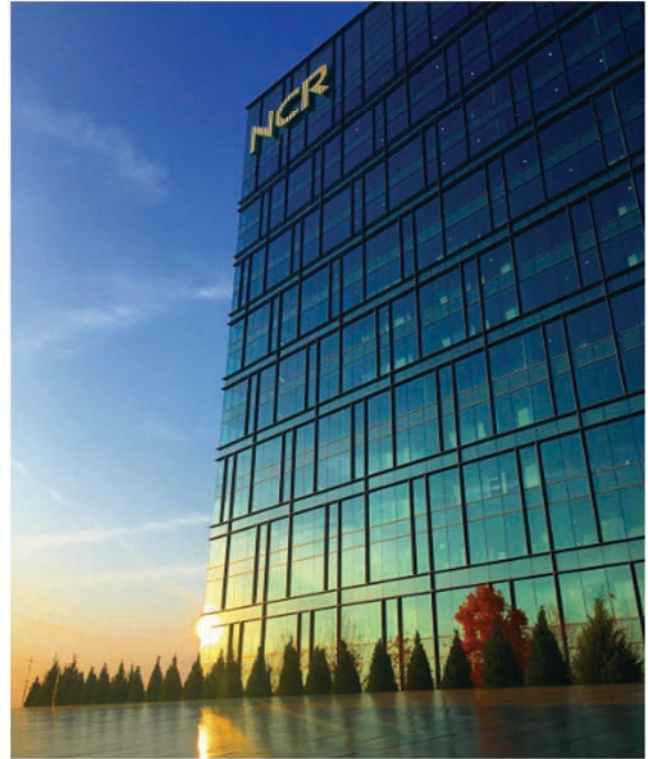

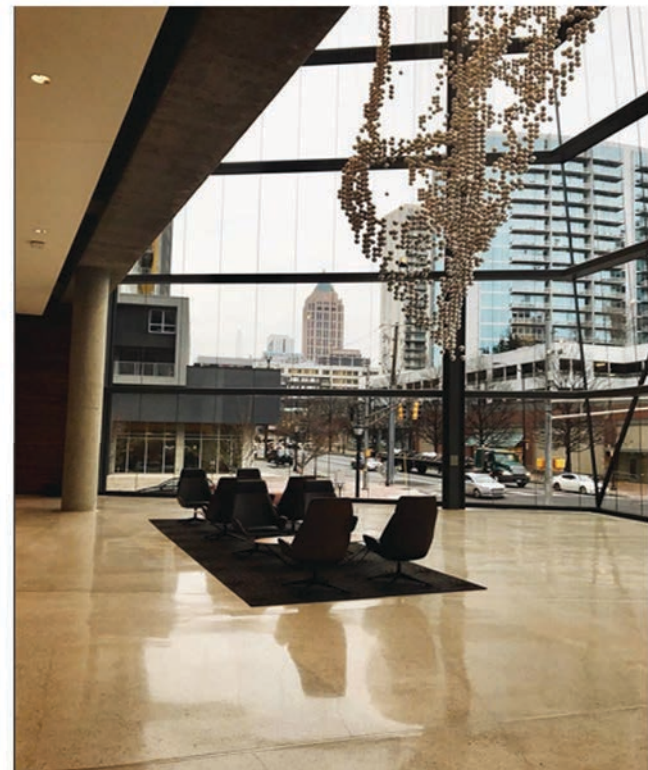


NCR aims for a new hub of technology

For technology giant NCR Corp., its new \$450 million headquarters is part of a larger vision: Turning Atlanta into the Silicon Valley of the East. The company's plan is to open its new midtown Atlanta headquarters in stages, with Tower 1 already filling up and Tower 2 set to open later this year.

Duda|Paine and Gensler worked on the project for NCR.

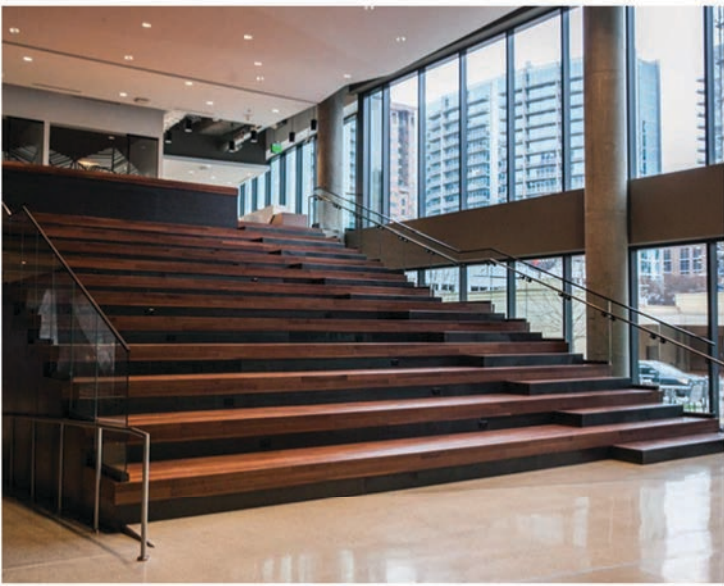
The new headquarters is certainly a departure from traditional office space. The complex's 5,000 workers — consolidated from offices throughout the Atlanta area — are ditching all their old furniture and won't have assigned work stations. Instead, they'll use an NCR Global Headquarters app to book a mobile workspace, meeting room, huddle room or other options, or even order lunch or nab a parking space.
