Commercial Real Estate Triad-based interior design group expands local office

MM Interior Design Group has added 2,800 square feet to its Greensboro office in Cornwallis Court.

A Triad-based interior design group is expanding its local office, nearly tripling its current space.

MM Interior Design Group purchased 2,800 square feet of space adjacent to its 609 State St. office in Greensboro's Cornwallis Court. The purchase increases the overall office size to 4,300 SF.

Peter Mitchell, the marketing manager of the group, which is owned and led by his spouse, Marta Mitchell, said MMIDG paid \$135,000 for the additional space, listed as 502-L and 502-O E. Cornwallis St. in Guilford County property records. MMIDG also owns its original space in Cornwallis Court.

MMIDG cited rapid growth for the addition. The new space will be renovated as a modern studio for their interior design team; conference rooms for client presentations; and also serve as libraries for tile, fabric and furnishing samples.

MMIDG, headquartered in Greensboro since 1989, also has a Denver office.
